## **Registration**

Registration fees are \$75 per person for the entire conference for CES members or \$100 per person for non-members. Please register by May 15. **Registration is now open at:** <https://www.cedarville.edu/eventreg/engineeringconference>.

## **Lodging**

---

You can sign up for lodging on the registration site. We will be staying in townhouse residence halls or for overflow dormitory style residence halls. Two night accommodations will be \$52 per person (covers both nights) for a double occupancy room, and \$104 for a single-occupancy room (taxes and linens included).

Approximately one mile away is the Hearthstone Inn, which is a good local option for those so inclined.

## **Meals**

You can sign up on the registration site for the banquet meal on Wednesday evening, for \$16 per person. You can also sign up for a package of all other meals during the conference for \$26 per person, served at the cafeteria. This covers from breakfast on Thursday morning through lunch on Friday. We do not have meal packages for longer or shorter periods. However, individual cafeteria meals are

available on a cash basis, and there are limited restaurants and coffee houses within one mile.
